Background: This is a postcard from Jakab Rusz to Agnes Heller's parents, 5 April 1944. Jakob wanted to call them, but no Jews had a telephone at that time, and his Christian friend, Dr. Hajdu did not allow him to use his phone. So, Jakab and his wife went to their death, no knowing that Agnes and her parents were able to hide in Budapest.

All of Jakab's children were survivors.
