

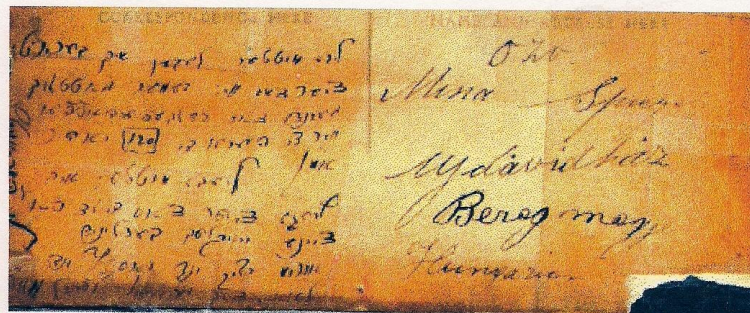
Photo Postcard
