We, the undersigned, of full age, being desirous of associating ourselves together for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, pursuant to and in conformity with Acts of the Legislature of the State of New York, relating to Membership Corporations, do hereby certify and declare that we are all of full age, two-thirds of us are citizens of the United States and _____ of us _____ resident of the State of New York.

We do further certify and declare as follows:

First.—That the particular objects for which said Corporation is formed are as follows, viz.:

- (a) To promote social welfare among the members of the association.
- (b) To voluntarily aid any member who might be sick or otherwise in distress.
- (c) To hold business and social meetings at such times and places as may be voted upon by the members of the association.
- (d) To hold social functions for the purpose of advancing either the social or financial interests of the association.
- (e) To open either a savings or business account wherein shall be deposited all moneys belonging to the association.

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Second.—That the name of said Corporation shall be FIRST POGREBISHT BENEVOLENT SOCIETY, INC.; the name corresponds to the City in Russia from which most of its members have emigrated to this country.

Third.—That the territory in which the operations of said Corporation are to be principally conducted is the County of Kings, City and State of New York.

Fourth.—That the principal office of said Corporation shall be located in the City of New York County of Kings and State of New York.

Fifth.—That the number of Directors of said Corporation shall be seven.

Sixth.—That the names and places of residence of the persons to be the Directors of said Corporation until its first annual meeting are:

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



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DIRECTIONS

Two-thirds of the incorporators must be citizens of the United States and one of them a resident of the State of New York (Gen. Corp. Law. Sec. 4).

An affidavit of the age, residence and citizenship of the incorporators is necessary under the decision in Matter of Wendover Athletic Association, 70 Misc. 273.

See that the annual meetings do not come upon Sunday.

If pecuniary aid to members is an object of the corporation, express it as "voluntary" aid.

If the name of a foreign city other than an English name is part of the name of the corporation, state that it is the name of a city, and where the city is located.

If one of the objects of the corporation is to promote fellowship and extend acquaintances, state the means by which this is to be carried out, e. g., social gatherings, lectures, etc.

Select a name which is dignified and not inappropriate to the purpose of the corporation.

Sign all first names in full; do not use initials.

The signatures of the subscribers must correspond exactly with their names in the acknowledgments and in the body of the certificate.

Do not make interlineations or write in pencil.

After the approval of a Supreme Court Justice is obtained, the original certificate is to be filed in the office of the Secretary of State, and the duplicate original in the office of the County Clerk.
