Application for erven Nos. 58 and 59 in the
Township of Upington by the Hebrew community

Sir,

I have the honour to forward herewith a letter from MR. R. Tilney of Upington bearing date the 13th September last giving cover to the Minutes of a meeting of the Hebrew community there of the 11th idem, and applying on their behalf for the grant of erven Nos. 58 and 59 in the Township of Upington for the purpose of erecting thereon a place of worship.

The erven in question aggregate an area of 130 square roods, 20.48 square feet, and are available for disposal.

It will be seen from the attached Minute from the Civil Commissioner, Gordenia, dated the 28th ultimo, that there is no objection on the part of the Municipal authorities to the application being acceded to, and I would therefore recommend a grant - at a fair valuation - to the Hebrew community of erven Nos. 58 and 59 under the provisions of section 6 of Act 15 of 1887, it being understood that the grantee pay the cost of survey and title.


In anticipation of my recommendation being approved the necessary three tracings and description of the erven are hereto attached for Parliamentary purposes.


