As you know, Ellen Garshick, our Yizkor Book Translation Project Manager, has completed editing the English translations of the 18 Kol Yotzei Pamphlets produced by the Organization of Kremenets Emigrants between 1967 and 1982. The Booklets report on activities of former Kremenetsers, including those associated with Shumsk, Vyshgorodok, and Pochayiv. Translations of the Hebrew parts of the Booklets now are online on our KDRG Contributors Google website.
