On behalf of the Kremenets Board, I wish you a very Happy New Year.

I have a special gift for all of our Contributors. Our KDRG Contributors website has been reorganized a bit and now has ALL of the vital records and revision list translation spreadsheets that have been completed so far. They are downloadable from:

You will see new links in the "Navigation" menu (left side of the page). These point to: "Translation Spreadsheets, RS" and "Translation Spreadsheets VR".

The vital records spreadsheets page allows you to download the following UNEDITED, pre-release spreadsheets.

These are not yet in either the Master spreadsheets nor the Concordance. They will not be released to the general public until they are fully processed.
