- Shumsk Marriages, 1883-1891, 1923-1926, 1935

The next steps are to have these records translated, add them to our vital records spreadsheets (available on the <u>Contributors Site</u>), and add the names and towns to the searchable <u>Kremenets Concordance Database Index</u>.
