1. [KREMENETZ](#) -

... KREMENETZ (Polish, Krzemieniec): District town in the government of Volhynia,...town in the government of Volhynia, Russia. The Jews of Kremenetz are first mentioned in a charter of privileges granted...Svidrigaila of Lithuania May 9, 1438, to the waywode of Kremenetz , the German Yurka. In this charter the latter is

2. [LEVINSOHN, ISAAC BAER](#): -

...LEVINSOHN, ISAAC BAER: Russian-Hebrew scholar and writer; born at Kremenetz Oct. 13, 1788; died there Feb. 12, 1860. His...Levin, was a grandson of Jekuthiel Solomon, who settled in Kremenetz and acquired considerable wealth, and a son of Isaac,...a satire on the Ḥasidim entitled "Dibre Ṣaddiḳim." Returning to Kremenetz in the same year, he began his "Te'uddah be-Yisrael,"

3. [HAZZAN, ABRAHAM BEN JUDAH](#): -

...ḤAZZAN, ABRAHAM BEN JUDAH: Cantor at Kremenetz , Volhynia, in the sixteenth century. In 1595, after recovering...different from his own, and, encouraged by Rabbi Samson of Kremenetz , he finished his book in the spring of 1597.

4. [LANDSBERG](#): -

...of scholars and philanthropists. Its founder was Abraham Landsberg of Kremenetz , who was born in 1756 and died in 1831...and Mendel Landsberg (1786 to Jan. 8, 1866) lived at Kremenetz , where they were born. Mendel was the more prominent,

5. [BERNSTEIN, IGNATI ABRAMOVICH](#): -

...BERNSTEIN, IGNATI ABRAMOVICH: Russian railroad engineer; born in Kremenetz , government of Volhynia, 1846; killed July 5, 1900, on

6. [ISAAC BEN NOAH COHEN SHAPIRA](#): -

...Talmudical training in the yeshibah of Ḥayyim ben Samuel of Kremenetz , and after filling the position of rabbi at Gorodnitza

7. [ABRAHAM MALAK](#) -

...follower of Ba'al Shem-Ṭob, and son-in-law of Meshullam Phœbus of Kremenetz ; died, while comparatively young, at Fastov, a village in  
RELEVANCY: 73.7%

8. [TEMERLS, JACOB BEN ELIEZER](#) -

...directed a Talmudical school at Lublin. Thence he removed to Kremenetz , where he passed the greater part of his life.

9. [FALK \(V05p332001.jpg\)](#), [JOSHUA BEN ALEXANDER HA-OHEN](#): -  
...of the Council of Four Lands in 1607, during the Kremenetz fair, many of his proposals were approved. In 1611

10. [CZACKI, TADEUSZ](#): -  
...and Kiev. In 1805 he founded the high school in Kremenetz , Volhynia, which was destined to be of inestimable  
benefit

..."Liḳ-Ḳuṭim," 43). Wolf b. Jacob ha-Levi Eppstein, who came from Kremenetz , Volhynia, was rabbi of Friedberg,

12. [GOTTLÖBER, ABRAHAM BAER](#) -  
...1830 he married for the third time and settled in Kremenetz , where he formed a lasting acquaintance with Isaac  
Bär

...Orsha, and other places. He reaffirmed the Magdeburg rights for Kremenetz Jan. 20, 1650; for Pinsk, Dec. 31,  
1650; he...31, 1650; he confirmed the privileges of the Jews of Kremenetz Jan. 26, 1650, and of the Jews of  
Pruzhaný  
RELEVANCY: 72.6%
14. [DUBNO](#): -  
...(also called Naḥman Lifsches); died in 1674; previously rabbi of Kremenetz (Volhynia) and Belz (Galicia); took part  
in the Council  
RELEVANCY: 72.2%
15. [LÖB B. JOSEPH \(REB LÖB SARAH'S\)](#): -  
...him by the superstitious people. R. Azriel of Kozin (near Kremenetz ), his pupil (according to Gottlöber, his  
driver), was considered

16. [SACHS, SENIOR](#): -  
...was arrested on the Russian frontier. He was brought to Kremenetz , where he was thrown into prison,  
remaining in confinement  
RELEVANCY: 71.9%
17. [HELLER, YOM-TOB LIPMANN BEN NATHAN BEN MOSES LEVI](#): -  
...of Vladimir, Volhynia. He attended the fairs of Yaroslav and Kremenetz , where the Council of the Four Lands  
met, and  
RELEVANCY: 71.3%
18. [MOSES BEN JACOB OF COUCY \(SeMaG\)](#): -  
...Elijah Mizraḥi's additions were printed also separately (Constantinople, 1520); Joseph Kremenetz likewise wrote a  
commentary on the "SeMaG," under the  
RELEVANCY: 71.3%

19. [OSTROG](#): -

...the formal protest, in 1758, of two rabbis, Löb of Kremenetz and Saul of Vladimir, against the conduct of the  
RELEVANCY: 71.2%

20. [COUNCIL OF FOUR LANDS](#) -

...Galicia with its capital, Lemberg), and Volhynia (capital, Ostrog or Kremenetz ). Lithuania seemed to have its regular or extraordinary representative

21. [COSSACKS' UPRISING](#): -

...Similar massacres took place in Zaslavl, Ostrog, Starokonstantinov, Bar, Narol, Kremenetz , and other towns of the Ukraine. ...Council of Four Lands. Later Jaffe accepted the rabbinate of Kremenetz . In 1592 he was called as rabbi to Prague;...1891-98; father of Moses Jaffe of New York). Meir of Kremenetz (David Tebele Efrat, in "Toledot Anshe Shem," p. 28,
