BIRTH: CYRLA SEYNENSKI Born 3/ 1866 Nowogrod

It happened in the town of Nowogrod on January 4th (16th), 1866, at 10 a.m. There appeared the Jew Dawid Izraelowicz Seynenski, cart maker, 38 years old, resident of Nowogrod, together with the witnesses, the Jews, Kuszel Lejbowicz Chmielewski, shames, age 56, and Lejzor Fiszlowicz Szafranowicz, synagogue caretaker, age 48, both residents of Nowogrod, and showed us a child of a female gender announcing that she had been born here in Nowogrod on December 20th, last year, at 10 a.m. of his lawful wife Dyna Gdalowna, 30 years old. This child was given the names Cyrla Dwoyra. Then this document was read aloud and signed by one of the witnesses only. The father of the child and the other witnesses were illiterate.

M 23 / 1893 Nowogrod –MEYER SEJNENSKI MARRIED CHANA BASZKIEWICZ WHO IS THE SISTER OF ESTHER BASZKIEWICZ

It happened in the town of Nowogrod on December 8th (20th), 1893, at 4 p.m. There appeared in person the Jew Chaim Juszk Fridman, member of the Nowogrod Jewish community, age 54, citizen of the town of Nowogrod, accompanied by the witnesses, Szklarzewski Abram, glazer, age 57, and and Majer Nadolny, inn-keeper, age 58, both residents of the town of Nowogrod, and announced that today in front of him a religious marriage had been concluded between Izrael Mejer Sejnenski, bachelor, 19 years old, son of the living Dawid and already deceased Dyna nee Dorfman, married Sejnenski, living in the town of Nowogrod together with his father, wheel-wright, and Hana Baszkiewicz, maiden, 20 years old, daughter of the living Szolim Moszek and Golda nee Krymkiewicz, family Baszkiewicz, born and still living in the town of Nowogrod together with her parents, turners by profession (lathe operator)

This marriage had been preceded by three announcements to the Jews gathered for prayer in the synagogue of Nowogrod on three Shabbat days, exactly on November 20th, 27th and December 4th, this year The newly-weds announced that no marriage agreement had been concluded. The permission for the marriage had been given by the parents of the groom and the bride. Then this document was read aloud to the representative of the kahal and the witnesses and signed by him and one of the witnesses. The other witnesses declared that they were illiterate.
