Certificate of Incorporation

We, the undersigned, of full age, being desirous of associating ourselves  
together for such purposes

as hereinafter is more particularly described, pursuant to and in conformity with Acts of the  
Legislature of the State of New York, relating to Membership Corporations, do hereby certify  
and declare that we are all of full age, two-thirds of us are citizens of the United States and  
all of us are residents of the State of New York.

We do further certify and declare as follows:

First.—That the particular objects for which said Corporation is formed are as follows, viz.:

To hold meetings for the intellectual  
and spiritual advancement of its  
members, and also for the benefit and  
charitable purposes and to assist its  
members in case of distress, to bury  
such, as may die.

Second.—That the corporate name by which said Corporation hereby to be formed shall be  
known and distinguished is and shall be Pohajec Young Men

Benevolent Association  
The word Pohajec being a town  
in Galicia, Austria



Third.—That the territory in which the operations of said Corporation are to be principally conducted in the City of New York  
Borough of Manhattan

Fourth.—That the principal office of said Corporation shall be located in the City  
of New York County of New York and State of New York.

Fifth.—That the number of Directors of said Corporation shall be Five

Sixth.—That the names and places of residence of the persons to be the Directors of said Corporation until its first annual meeting are:
