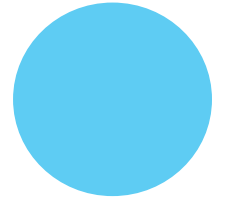

<b>Identity Papers 1934 NEW!</b> Includes Photos	In 1928 municipalities began to offer ID cards that were distinct from passports and applications are on file. Many of these documents contain photos as well as descriptive information that includes date and town of birth, parents' names, current address and profession. The full year of 1934 is available at the Polish Archives and the data and links have been extracted by JRI-Poland. You can find more information about this document <a href="#">here</a> . To locate them, go to JRI-Poland and enter the surname and Radom. There are hard copy records available from 1929-1933 and we hope to link to these as the years become fully digitized.
<b>Teachers' Surveys 1940 NEW!</b> Includes Photos	The Polish archives contain surveys completed by Radom's Jewish teachers that provide considerable family, educational and work background for twenty-one teachers. Each file contains a photograph. They are handwritten in Polish. Scans are not yet available on the <a href="#">radom link</a> , but if you find that any of the names that follow are relevant to your research please contact the Kehilalink webmaster for a copy. <b>Identity Papers 1941</b> Includes Photos	There are countless records on Radom in the Polish Archives. In 1941, the Jews of Radom were required to fill out identity papers. There are over 14,000 records on file and many of these have photographs. They are now on-line at the Polish Archives and you can find them <a href="#">here</a> . Other information includes date of birth, parents' names and address. You can pull all of the records of a given surname to look for relationships.
<b>Wartime Document Photos (separated from identity papers)</b>	The Jewish Historical Institute Genealogy Office has wartime document photos from Radom with the following surnames. <b>Bata Shoe Factory 1940s</b> Includes Photos	The Survivor and Victim Database at the US Holocaust Museum (USHM) has the files of 841 Jewish workers of the Bata Shoe Company who were employed as forced labor during WWII. The files frequently have photos and include descriptive information such as birth date, address and marital status. You can now access these records when you do a search on <a href="#">JRI-Poland</a> which links to the USHM or search the <a href="#">radom link</a> directly. Be sure to set the search on the USHM to D-M Surname. You can request the file via email and will receive it immediately at no charge. An advantage of searching just on the surname on JRI-Poland is that it will surface records where it represents a mother's maiden name, not just the employee's surname, and as a result may tie to other family members. The USHM will only pull up the employee. The scans are not yet available at the Polish Archives, but you can review the <a href="#">radom link</a> online in alphabetical order and it may remind you of additional family members to explore.
<b>Auschwitz Prisoner Photos 1941-42 NEW!</b>	The USHM has photos that were taken upon entry into Auschwitz. Data includes names, birth dates, date of entry and death and prisoner number. The ones that are available are from 1941-42 and can be found <a href="#">here</a> . Of 2530 records, there are 73 records for those who were born in Radom.
<b>Dachau Post-War Photos 1945 NEW!</b>	After the war, many survivors needed to prove they had been in Dachau to receive support from relief organizations. There are 2000 pictures (including some from Radom) for IDs provided dating to 1945. You can find the listing at Arolsen Archives <a href="#">here</a> . If you scroll down to Index for Photos. Click on that and you will see listings grouped by last names. You can also find them by searching the database for the individual by name.

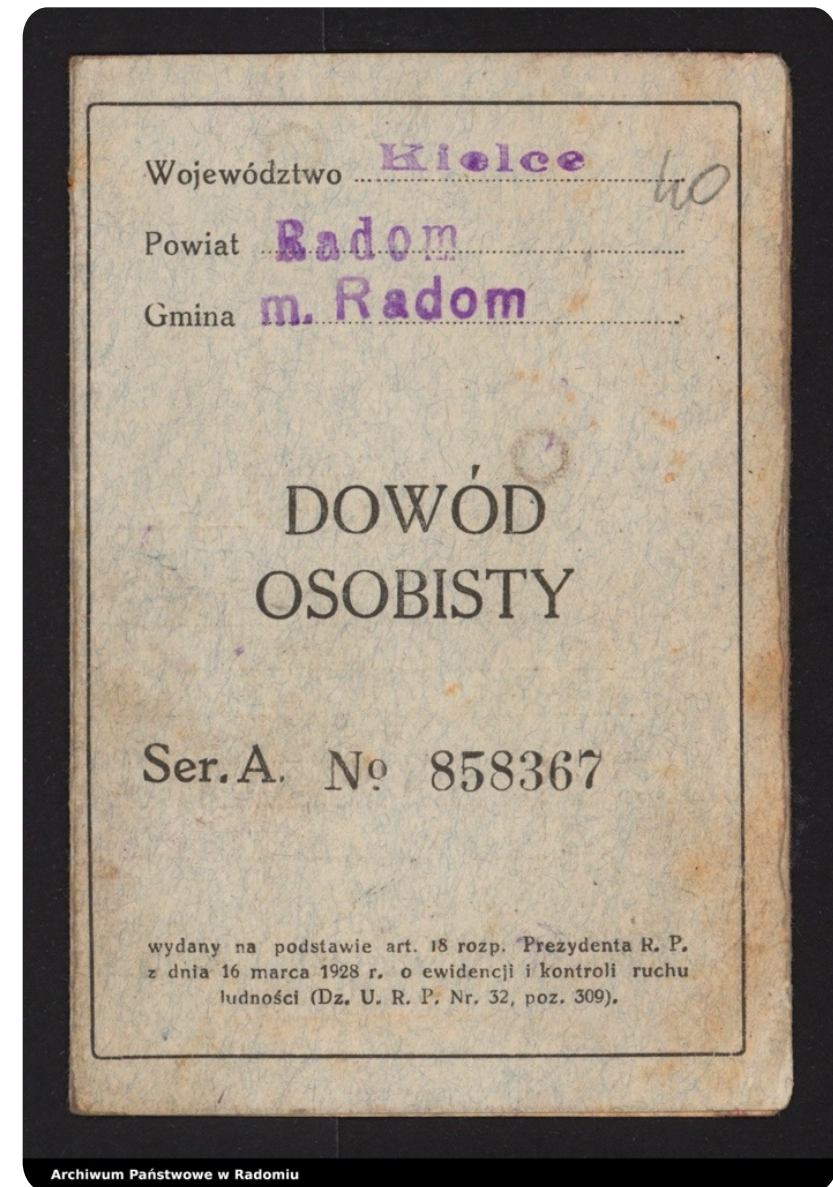

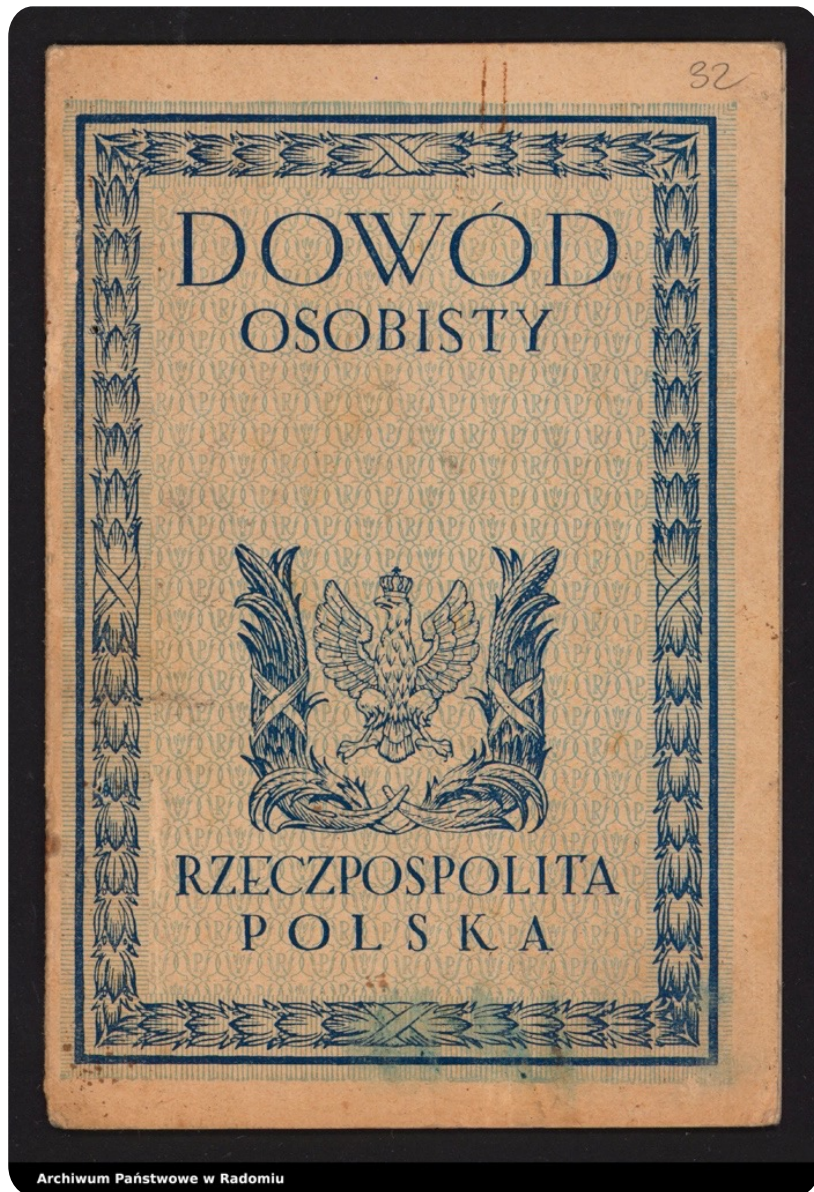
- An idea was hatched Aug 5, 2021, at Radom BOF
- Post meeting conversation on ID records from 1930s
- Searched archives to check on on-line availability
- Spoke with Steve Taubman, Radom Town Leader for JRI-Poland
- Connected with Judy Golan, Area Coordinator for JRI-Poland
- Located complete record set in 1934, others yet to be digitized
- A 24/7 operation - Susan and Judy tag teamed on links and extraction
- Susan pulled relevant links for Google spreadsheet in Minnesota
- Time difference allowed for seamless handoff maximizing use of time
- Judy extracted information from links into shared spreadsheet
- Stanley Diamond fast-tracked it for JRI-Poland
- Took flight -accessible online through JRI-Poland on Aug 22, 2021



# 1929-1934 Identity Papers

- 1929 -1934 Radom PSA holds municipal ID cards, these are distinct from passports
- Only 1934 is completely scanned
- Folder content
  - ID Card Application Forms
  - Address Cards (proof of residency)
  - Permanent resident details
  - Birth affidavits

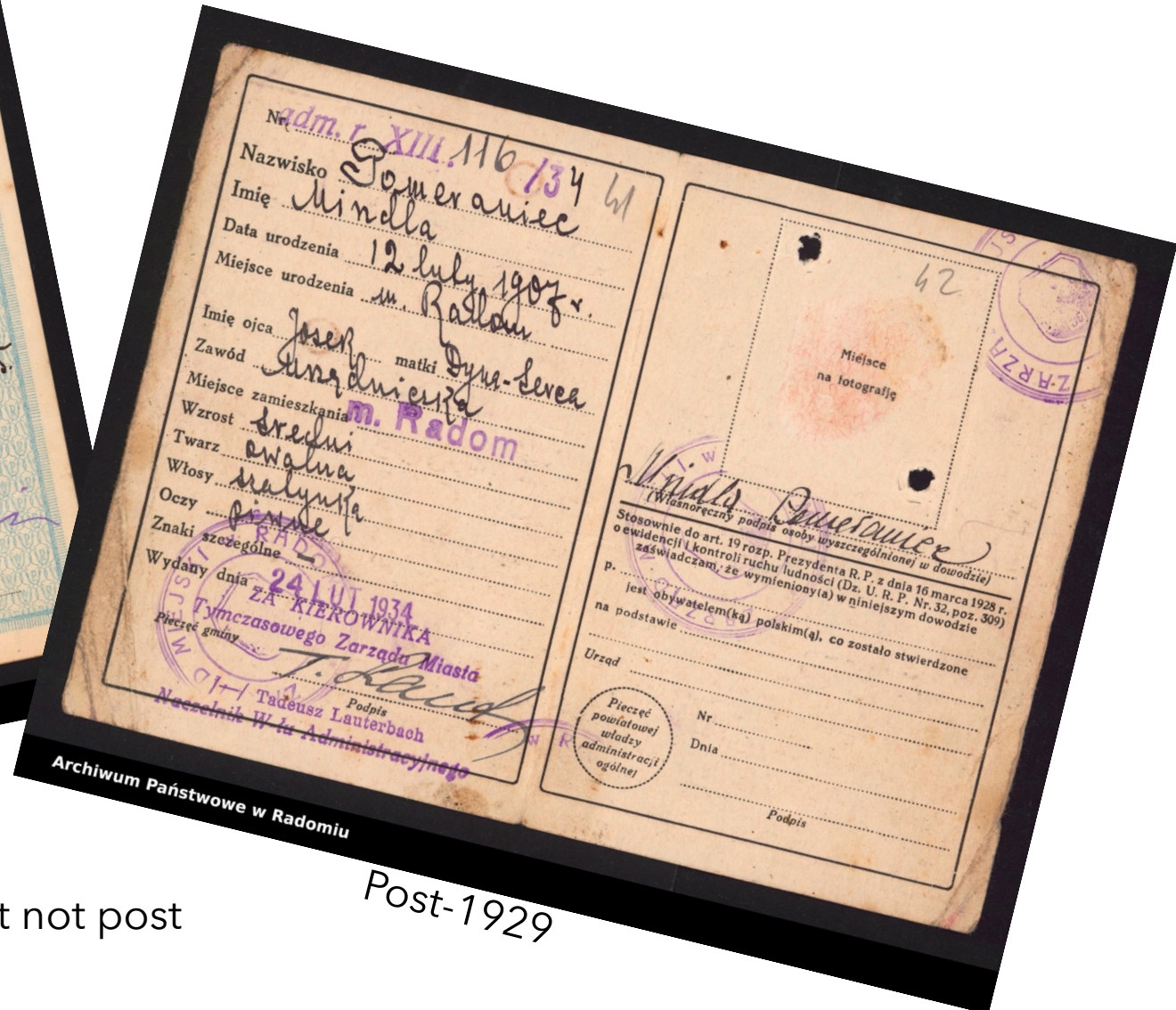




# Identity Papers 1918-1928

- 1918 -1928: ID booklets had a dual function as municipal ID Card *and* Polish Passport
- Issued by district on behalf of the country
- Some are included in the 1929-1934 Radom municipal ID filings

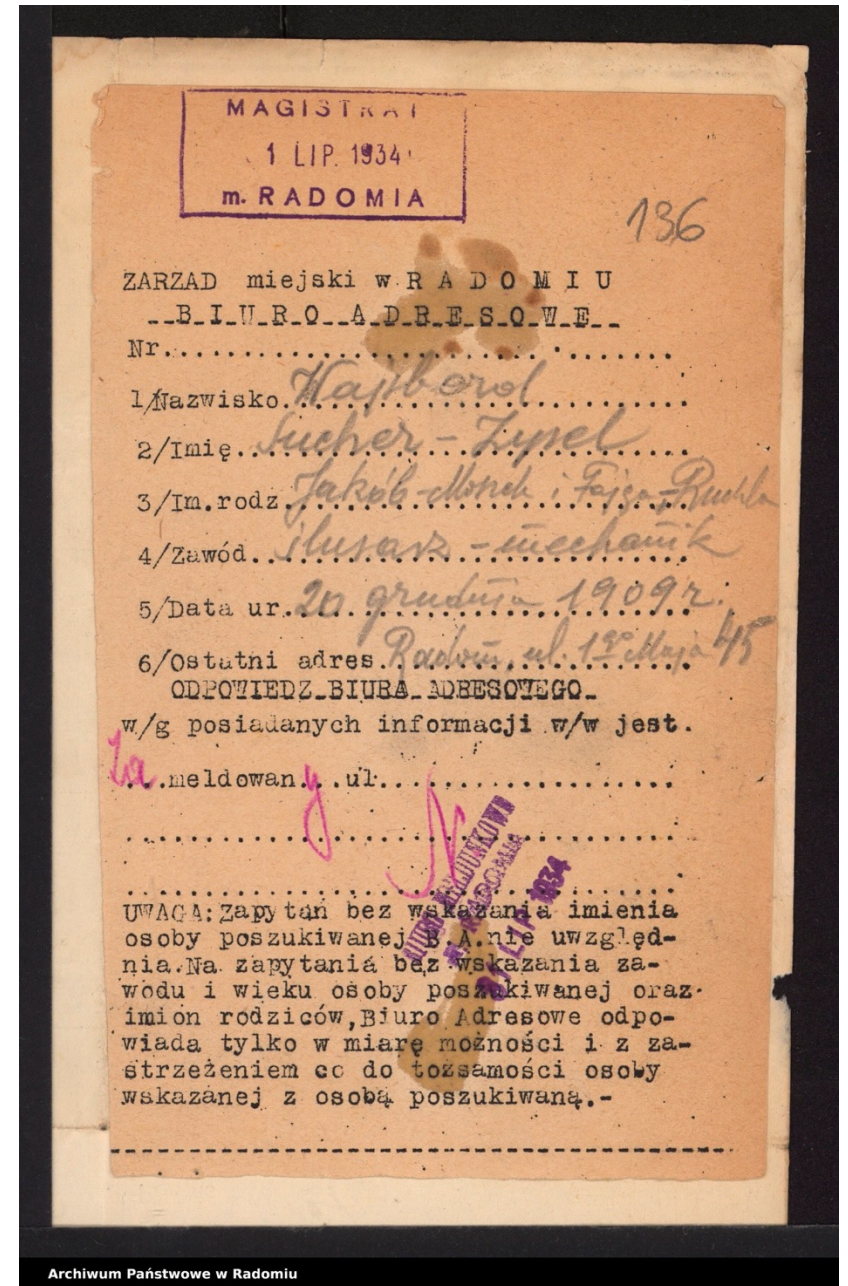

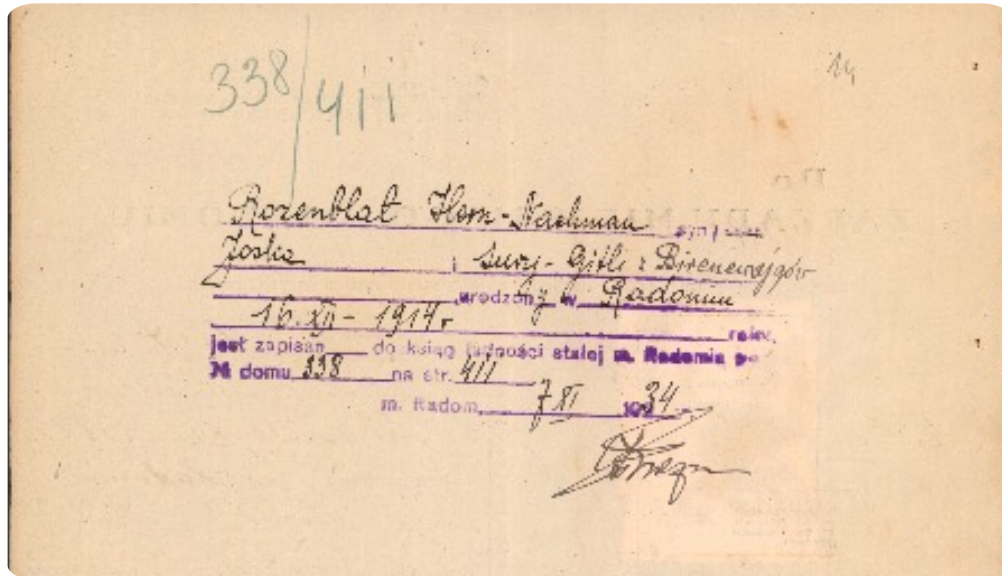

# Bata Shoe Factory Records

- The Radom branch of Polska Spolka Obuwia "Bata" S.A. footwear manufacturer
- In early 1942, it employed 2400 people, 30% were Jewish forced laborers
- The Jews were craftsmen (tailors, shoemakers, leather stitchers, furriers), who received a small amount of cash and a bowl of soup for their work.
- In August 1942, the Nazis liquidated the ghetto, and most were sent to Treblinka



# Bata Shoe Factory Records

- Forced Labor records 1941-1942 for 840 Jewish workers, many with photos
- Can search through JRI-Poland which extracts the data and provides the link to the Survivors and Victim Database at the US Holocaust Museum
- Name search will locate the record. Be sure to set the search to D-M Soundex to allow for varieties of spellings. You can order it by email for no cost and immediate email delivery.

Sucher Zysel Wajsbort was born in Radom, Poland in 1909. He was a metalworker and single. Prior to WWII he lived in Radom, Poland. During the war he was in Radom, Poland.

# Dachau Survivor IDs - Arolsen Archives

- A photo card file from the former Dachau concentration camp post-war
- 2,000 photos of survivors
- Created for victims of Nazi persecution who needed certificates of their imprisonment to receive support from relief organizations.
- To prove that they had been in the Dachau camp, and how long they had spent time there, they had to submit two photos of themselves—one for the files, and one to glue to the certificate.
- Digitized and indexed, can search by name or birthdate.

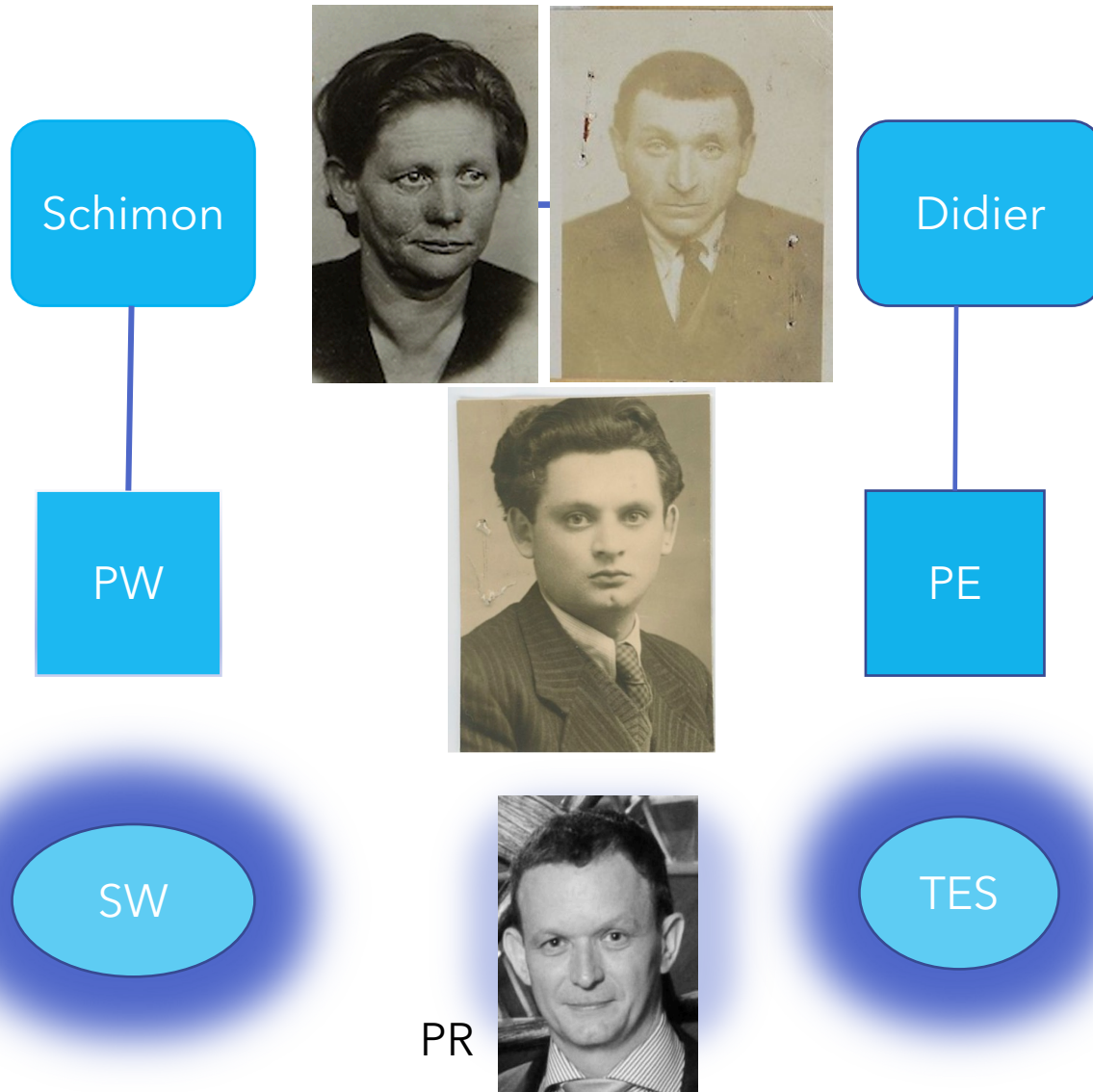
