

Addresses of Jewish Families in Komjat prior to the Holocaust

Each home in Komjat was assigned a number. An address consisted of that number, and not the name of the street. I have found the number listed on 3 types of documents-

K- Kassa form that was filled out on April 16th as the valuables of the Jewish residents were being confiscated

P- Persecuted list

S- Survivors list

The last 2 lists were created by the Extraordinary State Commission.

The table below lists the address number's found on documents, the family names listed for those numbers and the type of document the number was found on (K, P or S)
