

Oct 1924(?)

Up till 1924 there were about 45 Jewish Colonies with about 40,000 inhabitants in the section of Kherson, Nikolaiev, Elizavetgrad, Krivorrshesky, Zaporoshky, Mariupolsky, occupying about 275,000 acres of land.

After 1924 there were a good many other groups or colonies. Most of the the new Jewish Colonists have settled in the Crimea, Mariupol, Nikolaiev and Kherson sections.

About 100,000 acres of land were plowed and planted with our tractors for the Jewish Colonies up till October 1924.

NEWLY ORGANIZED COLONIES IN CRIMEA  
SEASON OF 1923 and 1924

(Names given below are Hebrew names)

Telchae (Hill of life) 3,000  
Telchae is organized by 70 young boy chalutzims and girls whose ages range from 19 to 20 years. The colony is located three miles from the station Kolya. All the work in this colony is done by the boys and girls and it is really surprising how wonderfully well these city youngsters have taken to farm work. Four tractors have been placed there and with the instructions that we gave them, they are now able to operate and repair the tractors as well as any mechanic. 3,000 Acres were plowed up by them.

Mishmar, is located two miles from the station of 1,000 of Taggnach, consisting of 30 members also ranging from the ages of 19 to 25 years, and are doing just as well as the Telchae colony. They have plowed about 1,000 acres in 1924 with one tractor.
