This year they are bringing their own families and another two families and two single men to assist us to make up a *minyan*.

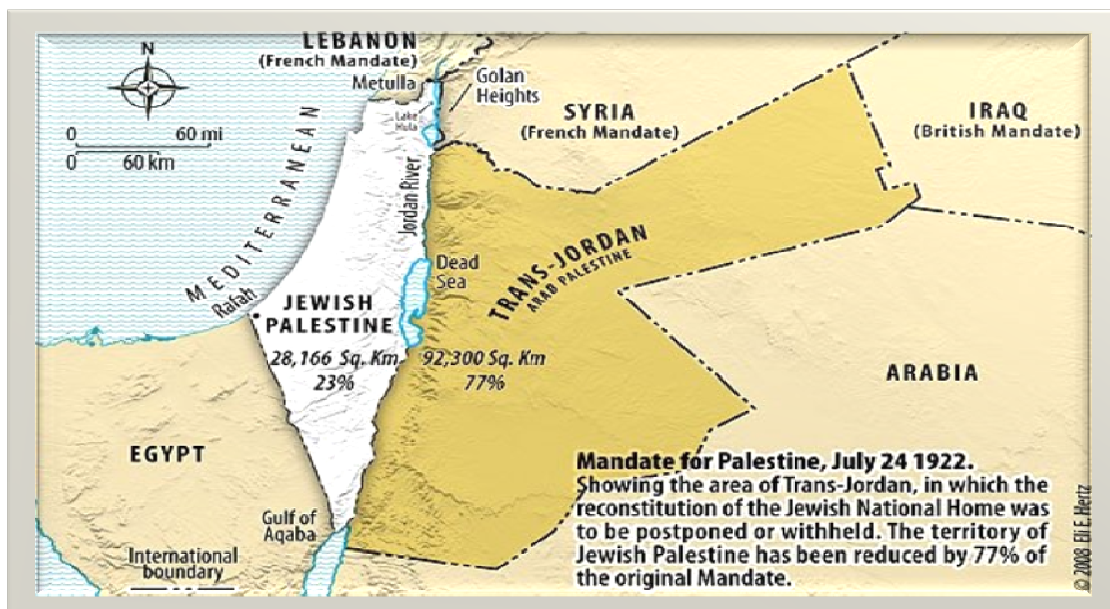
