Shlomo Suoma Verzoub Rivas: Author and Speaker by Judy Goldberg



My maternal grandmother Yente Verzoub was from Uman, Ukraine. The daughter of Mordechai Verzoub and Hinda Levi-Goodman. As far as we know, Mordechai and Hinda had three daughters, Yente, Tania, Genia and two sons, Menachem Mendel and Shlomo Suoma. We do not have birth dates but Shlomo must have been born in the 1880's. He married Rivka (maiden name unknown) and changed his name to Rivas in her honor. They moved to Moscow

and he landed a teaching position in literature in the Moscow University. He was a talented author and speaker. The photo shows him and Riva with their child, around 1928. He and Riva died tragically around 1950 in the "Authors' Massacre," leaving two children.

His sister Tania Verzoub married Boris Reznikov or Reznik and had three daughters Sarah, Dora and Bella who must have been born on 1910's. From old letters we learned that the daughters also moved to Moscow and one or two of them worked, in a high position, for the national radio and TV.
