FREJDA BASZKIEWICZ BORN 1868 NOWOGROD POLAND

This event took place in the city of Nowogrod-- a Jewish gentleman named Szolim Moszk Baszkiewicz a turner by trade-forty five years of age appeared in person in the presence of Jewish witnesses: Lejb Kon, sexton, seventy-three years of age and Kusel Chmielewski, a laborer of seventy four years of age also residing in Nowogrod and presented to us a female newborn, declaring that she was born in Nowogrod on the third/the fifteenth of April eighteen sixty-eight at six oclock in the morning to his legally bound wife Golda Krymkiewicz (maiden name), forty-one years of age. The newborn child was named Frejda and due to the absence of her father, was not reported immediately.

The completed act of a declaration of civil existence took place in Nowogrod on the sixteenth of April, the eighth of May, eighteen eighty one at eleven oclock in the morning. Only the father signed the document since the witnesses declared themselves illiterate.
