MARRIAGE DOCUMENT OF LEJBA LEJZOROVITCH KASAVICHEM AND CHINKA MOSZKOVNA KRAMKOVSKAYA PARENTS OF BORUCH MOSZK KASAVICHEM BORN 1880 NOWOGROD POLAND

A wedding took place in the town of Nowogrod on February 13/25 1873 at 3 pm. a jew- Gershon Meltzerovitch—the rabbi of Nowogrod showed up in the presence of the jewish witnesses-Jushka Jankelovitch Rosenbaum a salesman sixty eight years old and Khushelja Leonovitch Chmelevskij-a worker sixty four years old—both are citizens of Nowogrod-and declared before them on this day, a religious wedding ceremony (chuppah) took place between the chosson (groom) Lejba Lejzorovitch Kasavichem unmarried, twenty year old son born to and living with his lawful parents Lejzor Berkovitch and Zlata Mejerowna Kasewicz, , shoemakers who live in the town of Sniadowo and the kallah (bride) Chinka Moszkovna Kramkovskaya a girl of twenty five and daughter of the married couple Moshka and Malka Kramkowski (Moshka being deceased) Chinka living with Malka in the town of Nowogrod

Preceding this wedding ceremony was a three time announcement on February 5-12-19 of this year, and on 11-19- and 25 of December 1871 in the halls of Nowogrod and Sniadowo to the people gathered for prayer during shabbos day---and as there appeared to be no objections to this marriage it is now valid.

Accordingly the newlyweds declared that they agree not to marry again(and that they have not been married before)

This document was read to the people present by the rabbi's witnesses and me fulfilling duties of the official of the civil cases and signed—(Rozenbaum) Nowogrod –Sniadowo - 1873
