We, the Undersigned, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the membership Corporations Law, all being of full age, at least two thirds being citizens of the United States and one of us a resident of the state of New York, do hereby Certify and State;

First. The particular objects for which the corporation is to be formed are to Promote Social intercourse among our members, to help and afford <sup>voluntarily</sup> aid and assistance to them when in distress.

Second. The name of the proposed corporation is Portchase Young Mens Benevolent Association; the name Portchase being a name of a City located in Austria;

Third. The territory in which its operations are to be principally conducted is New York City and State of New York.

Fourth. The town, village or city in which its principal office is to be located is the ~~Borough~~  
of Manhattan, State of New York, New York in the County of New York and
