The data bank of: Los vecinos Judios de mis abuelos Singer has around six thousands and five hundred entries. From this repository I was able to locate about 2462 certain burial places in different geographical points From other any hundreds I have only not so certain information generally as "died before year so and so" or "after year so and so"

2234 persons lived and died in Lucienville (Baso Akerman Escribia)

14 moved to similar places of similar characteristics in the same province of Entre Rios no far away from their first habitat

10 Moved to Towns also nearby in Entre Rios

162 were the total of people who died outside Entre Rios, from them, from Tucuman in the North of the country down to Rio Negro of this total of 162

125 made to the big aple to Buenos Aires

14 settled somewhere inside Argentina

Those are the numbers of people who abandoned Basavilbaso but remain Argentinians

26 Made Alyah to Issrael and here in this country are buried

12 went to the U S A - Others died in Panama, Mexico, Brazil, Venezuela and 2 even returned their Russian origins
